#### **CLOSED MEETINGS**

The public is hereby informed that notices for Bell County Water Control and Improvement District No. 1 meetings will no longer distinguish between matters to be discussed in open or closed session of a meeting. This practice is in accordance with rulings by the Texas Attorney General that under the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551; the Board may convene in a closed session to discuss any matter listed on the agenda without prior or further notice, the matters authorized under meetings known as "Executive Sessions", include the following: (1) purchase of real property; (2) security measures; (3) receipt of gifts; (4) consultation with attorneys; (5) personnel matters; (6) any economic development; and (7) homeland security matters. The governing body must first convene in open session, identify one of the seven listed exceptions and cite the time and applicable exception.
